After graduating from King's in 1947, Peter had a long and successful career, principally in the oil and gas, petrochemical, refining and chemical industries, working on and leading projects around Europe, South America, North Africa and the Middle East.

After retiring, he became a neighbourhood engineer, visiting and advising schools and colleges and helping with science and technology projects. He was also involved with the restoration of The Kempton Great Engines at Sunbury from the beginning, serving as Chief Engineer for many years.
